

Help I am an art manager 24-25

To assist those teachers becoming a primary art manager to consider all the things necessary to effectively lead art in a primary school.



This multi-session course is run over three sessions and provides an opportunity to develop an understanding and knowledge of the requirements to lead and manage art in a primary school.

It will enable teachers to work together to conduct action research and develop materials to challenge teaching and learning in art and design and to provide exemplar materials for art resources. As a group, teachers will have the opportunity to then share their experiences and identify needs for development.

Learning Outcomes

- Provision for disadvantaged children in art.
- Coverage, enrichment and sharing resources created.
- Enhancement of practical ideas through 'hands on' workshop opportunities.
- An understanding of progression of skills in art and age-related expectations (AREs).
- Self-review and auditing to identify management and subject leadership role requirements.
- Using action research principles to enable review and evaluation to inform identified needs for developments.
- Best practice principles for planning, assessment teaching, managing in art to enable pupils to progress effectively.
