Abeer specialises in hand-dyed and screen-printed textiles, working with local communities focused on representation, inclusivity and visibility. She experiments with delicate designs, using bold colours and layering techniques to craft unique silk scarves and textile wall hangings. Through her practice she processes her thoughts on belonging, sense of identity and representation.

She received the Craft Skills Award in 2021 and has been recognised by The Society of Dyers and Colourists. Her work is stocked in Liberty of London and many prestigious galleries.

Workshop

Hands-on block printing experience using geometric structures from the South Asian and Persian empires.

Katherine Anteny – Southampton based printmaker

Katherine has taught printmaking techniques to adults and children for 20 years in studios, schools, universities and other more unusual settings. She is primarily a linocut artist and also prints with letterpress type from her home studio.

Workshop

Session in making vibrant multicolour prints using soft cut lino. This soft relief printing material is ideal for younger users (Katherine has taught using this material in schools many times and will allay any fears of cut fingers).
