- How does the work relate to your theme?
- What do you particularly like or not?
- How can the work inspire your own work?
- What will you do to continue your investigations prompted by the artist?

A02: REFINE

work by exploring ideas, selecting and experimenting with appropriate media, materials, techniques and processes.

- How have you adapted the materials in your final ideas?
- What are you thinking about as you try out the techniques and materials to create your response?
- Which combinations of ideas and materials work well?
- What else could you do/or have you tried?
- What process have you tried- is it like an artist? How?
- What might you try next or try differently?
- How do you feel you can improve your work?
- How will you present your work so far?
