

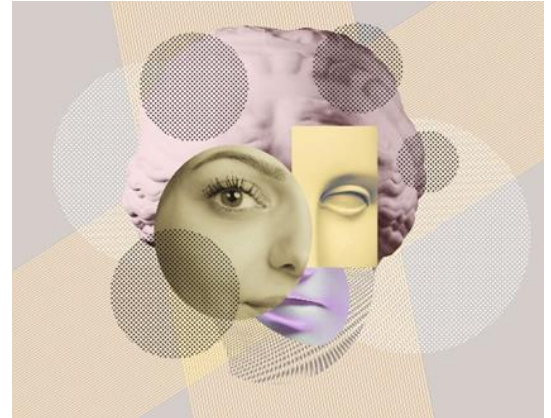
# Enhancing Skills and Techniques in the Primary Art Curriculum 2022-23

- Conduct mini action research projects individually and share with the group collaboratively.

- Experimenting with activities in school and sharing outcomes
- Sketchbook work over the duration of the course
- Support with disseminating knowledge back in school including through leading INSET, staff meetings etc.
