

Art Support Afternoon Workshops

These termly workshops offer teachers a valuable afternoon opportunity to participate in practical activities and meet other teachers to share ideas and thoughts about art in the classroom.

Summer topic – Make do and mend with art textiles
Autumn topic – Sketchbooks and cultural drawing
Spring topic – Geometric patterns and collage



Learning Outcomes:

- To use different skills, techniques, and materials in practical art workshops.
- An appreciation of a progression of skills related to the theme of the workshop session.
- Establish ideas for developing practical tasks into planning and considerations for teaching and learning in the primary classroom.
- To use a sketchbook as a research tool to explore, experiment, organise and store information, and reflect a learning journey.
- To feel more confident and be able to model skills and thinking in art with children and colleagues.

These afternoon workshops will happen once per term and will follow the content of the twilight art support workshops, and these will be offered as three-hour sessions.
