Topics for the year:

Autumn: "Swish! Swoop! Sketch!" Expressive drawing

Summer: "Snip! Sew! Surprise!" Adventures with textiles

Learning outcomes:

- To use different skills, techniques, and materials in practical art workshops.
- To use a sketchbook as a research tool – to explore, experiment, organise and store information, and reflect a learning journey.
- Develop an appreciation of a progression of skills related to the theme of the workshop session.
- Have ideas for developing practical tasks into planning and considerations for teaching and learning in the primary classroom.
- To feel more confident and able to model skills and thinking in art with children and colleagues.
