Following the successful *Our Climate Change Forest project 2020-21* and *Our Climate Unity project 2020-21*, you are invited to participate in the continuation project to address a range of perspectives on the climate issue facing us all and to provide an opportunity for these perspectives.

Opportunities will also be available by other subject areas this year. I will continue to offer schools the opportunity to express their thoughts on climate issues through the medium of art

This year you are invited to create two-dimensional artwork that will provide artwork towards a digital continuous exhibition. Some actual artworks will also be needed for exhibition. The artwork can be any size up to A1 and can be drawing, painting, collage, textiles, mixed media, photography etc.

We are planning to have a pupil conference on Friday 14 July 2023 in Elizabeth II Court, Ashburton Hall, Winchester. Pupils will have the opportunity to share what they are doing and thinking about their climate concerns and to attend workshops and talks.

Two workshops are available for you to attend to find out more information and they will provide ideas and inspiration for you to develop artwork that can contribute to art exhibitions (virtual and physical) with and by Hampshire schools and in your own school. It will also enable you to communicate your school's message and to raise awareness about climate change, unity, stewardship and environmental issues.
