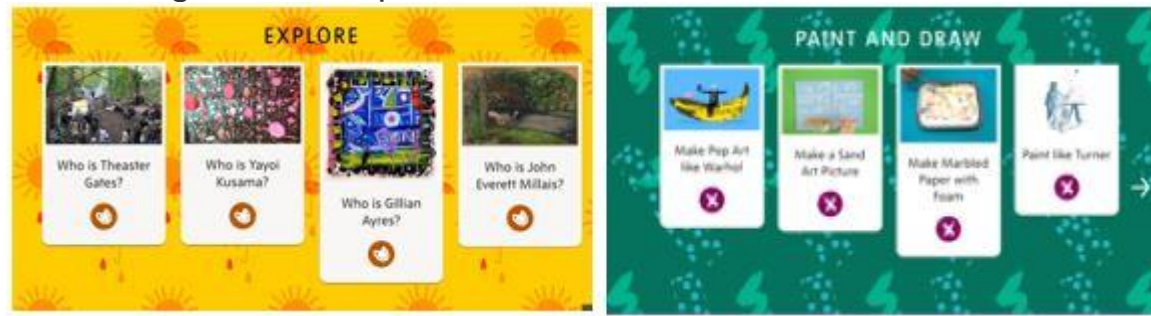

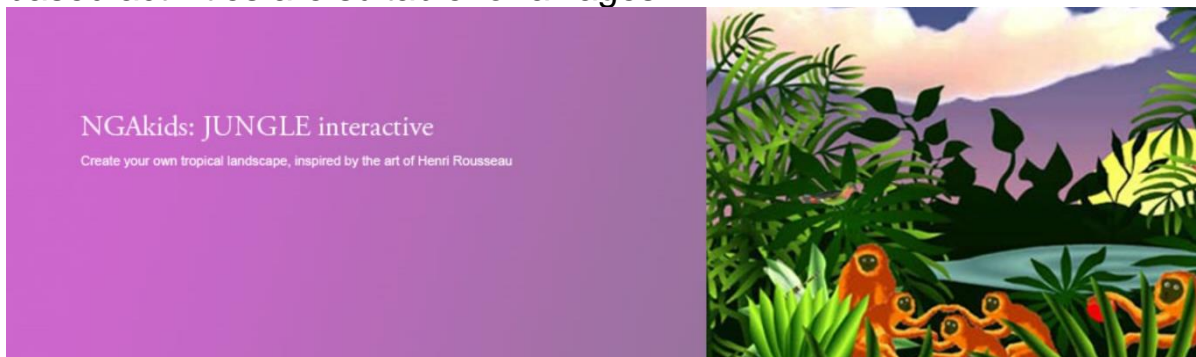

### Nrich

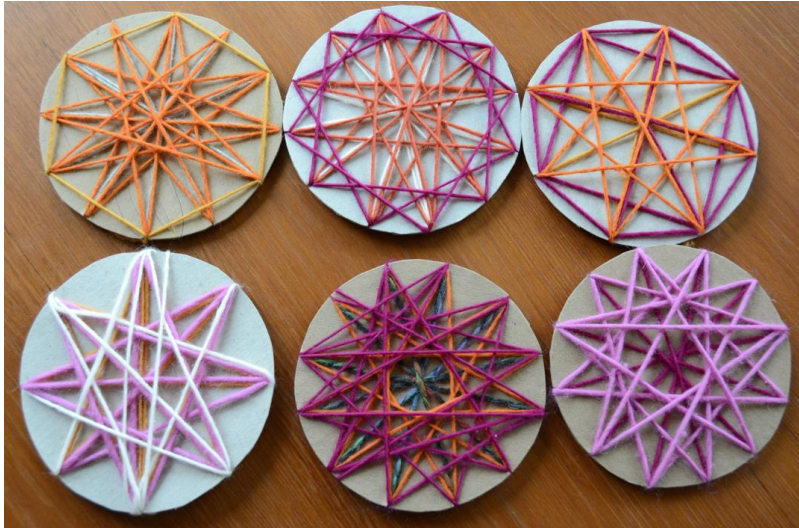



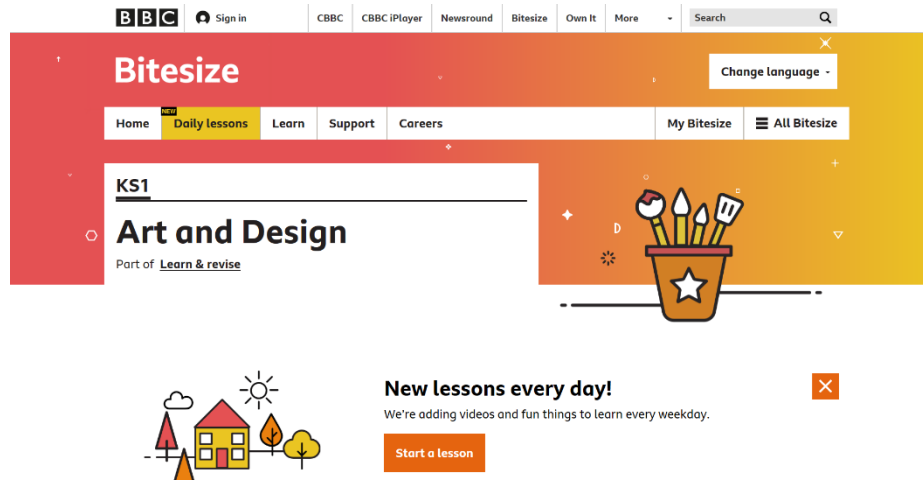
